PURPOSE

- The purpose of the scholarship is to assist student/resident who otherwise do not qualify for scholarships based on academic achievements.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must:

- Be a resident of Kauai County and be of Filipino ancestry. Children or grandchildren of KFCC (*Kauai Filipino Chamber of Commerce*) member in good standing
- Be a graduating senior from any public or private high school in Kaua'i, and must be in good academic standing.
- Have been accepted into any four year accredited College/University or Junior College/Community College.

RECIPIENTS MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF ACCEPTANCE INTO A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY.

JUDGING CRITERIA

FINANCIAL NEED

- Applicants must demonstrate a financial need. Must have applied for FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). SAR (Student Aid Report) must be submitted with this application. No exceptions will be made.

SCHOLASTIC

- Must have maintained a minimum of a 3.0 grade point average (B average) on a 4.0 scale. Applicant must submit a current official transcript of grades and SAT or ACT scores with this (Only 4 year College/University Level applicants need to submit SAT or ACT scores).

RESUME Academic Achievements and Leadership & Community Service

- Honors, extra-curricular activities such as student government, sports, various committees, organizations, and school-sanctioned clubs. (i.e. JROTC, Band, Scouts, Volunteer work etc.)

ESSAY OR PERSONAL STATEMENT OR ESSAY

- Personal statement on why you are applying for a scholarship.
Minimum of 400 words typewritten.

TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

- Letters from teachers, employers, ministers or any non-related individuals who can attest to applicant's character and potential.
